

1. Introduction

The O Δ K Circle Annual Report is an important information-gathering tool for the organization. The data gathered helps the staff and committees better understand the work of our circles as well as provide crucial insight into programs and services needed by the circles.

Completion of the Circle Annual Report is required by the O Δ K Policies and Procedures Handbook [Sec. 360]. Some information in the Circle Annual Report will be used to determine Circle Recognition Awards. The tag [CMS] on items means it is a requirement of the Circle Minimum Standards. This item must be answered and must meet the CMS in order for circles to qualify for Circle Recognition Awards. If a section is tagged, it means every item in that section is required for CMS.

This report form has 50 items and will take approximately 30 minutes to complete. You can complete the survey in parts.

Survey Monkey will allow you to save your entries and come back to them at a later time by clicking the exit link, however, you must return to the survey on the same computer and the same IP address from which you started it.

The Circle Annual Report is due no later than Friday, June 30, 2023, at 11:59 p.m. EDT.
